Rainbow in the Dark is the culmination of artworks created by the beneficiaries of Singapore Association of the Visually Handicapped, created from weekly art-as-therapy workshops conducted by Singaporean art therapist Loh Wan Ting. Questioning personal perceptions of what is the norm such as the “Do not touch” label found in visual arts exhibition, the artists invite viewers to take a personal journey with them to appreciate the arts through their sense of touch in the dark.

This exhibition hopes to generate more awareness, to facilitate more opportunities for social interaction and social inclusion for the beneficiaries through arts.

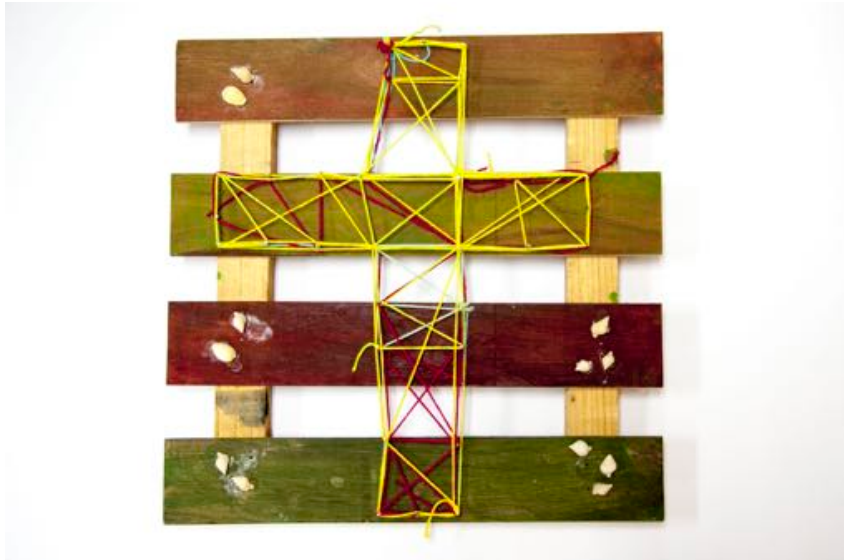

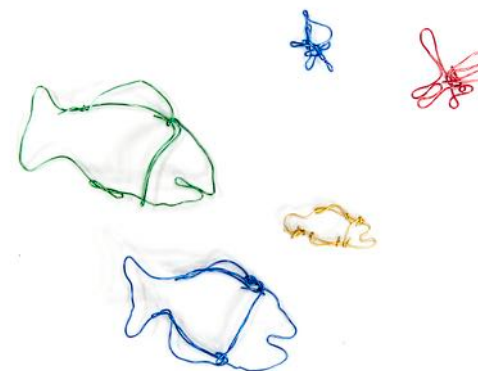
